Lesson Plan Title/Overview: Painting with scissors like Matisse

Grade Level/Course: 2nd Grade

Duration: 2-3 40-minute class periods

P.A. State Standards Addressed:

9.1.3.H Handle materials, equipment and tools safely at work and performance spaces

- Identify materials used.
- Identify issues of cleanliness related to the arts.
- 9.2.3.A. Explain the historical, cultural and social context of an individual work in the arts

Overall Goal:

- Have student practice their scissor and gluing skills
- Have students practice laying out their shapes before gluing
- Introduce students Henri Matisse and appreciate his art form

Objective(s):

- Student creates collage of different shapes and colored construction paper
- Student identifies Matisse as the artist who originated this style

Resources/Materials and Teaching Aids:

Henri's Scissors

Focus / Motivation/ Essential Question(s): How can you paint with scissors?

Vocabulary:

Henri Matisse

Procedure(s): step by step process in which the lesson will occur including learning activities.

Be sure to include an example of both:

- 1. **Guided Practice**: this is where teachers "model" while students observe and follow sequential instructions.
- 2. **Independent Practice**: this is when students will complete steps of the project independently with the Teacher circulating the room to moderate comprehension.

Introduction: Video of Henri Scissors

Guided Practice: Present how to cut with scissors to create a paper painting. Explain that all the shapes can be different sizes and any shape they can imaging. I will have tracers for some of the harder shapes such as the spirals and zig zags.

Gather materials: I will instruct students to gather scissors and their paper. Every student will start with a black or white piece of card stock.

- I will disperse colored paper to all of their tables for them to share. Then they can start cutting. As they cut I will answer questions and assist as necessary.
- After a while of cutting, most likely a later class, we will start laying out the pieces to get and idea of how they want their collages to look. Then we will start to glue. I will give a tutorial on proper gluing technique.

Closure/Comprehension Questions: this is when the teacher announces clean up time, reviews

the daily lesson and assesses student understanding etc.

Extensions:

Pre-cup pieces for students with mobility challenges,

More advanced shapes for gifted students

Evaluation and Assessment: this is how a teacher will assess or grade students on the lesson. Assessments could be in the form of a rubric, test, artist statement etc.
